

Saugus ACES Code of Conduct

As a participant in Saugus ACES, you agree to the following Code of Conduct:

1. No slide-tackling (except for goalkeeper in own penalty area).
2. No foul, insulting, or abusive language.
3. No fighting (regardless of who started it).
4. No “dirty” play, including but not limited to taunting both verbally and physically, or retaliating for an earlier perceived injustice.
5. No repeated dissent with officials, including the league board. You can complain once per season, so use it wisely.
6. Respect the game, play fairly and follow its rules and regulations.
7. Show respect for authority to the officials of the game and of the league.
8. Demonstrate good sportsmanship before, during and after games.
9. Help parents and fans understand the league philosophy so they can watch and enjoy the game.
10. Be courteous to opposing teams and treat all players and coaches with respect.
11. Be modest when successful and be gracious in defeat.
12. Respect the privilege of the use of public facilities.
13. Refrain from the use of drugs, tobacco, alcohol and abusive language.
14. Help setup and take down goals and other field equipment as needed.
